- 3. Take your chili to the judges' table in the CHILI COOK-OFF TENT by 2:30 pm.
- 4. Feel free to bring any promotional materials, printed recipes, or decorations for your area.

- 5. Tell everyone you know to come out to the event, to taste the chili, and to vote! Tables, electric, napkins, tasting cups, and spoons will be provided.
